The aim of this **interactive practical workshop** is to encourage **clinical radiographers** to undertake research and to instill a research culture in the radiography profession. The workshop will help kick-start the research potential of radiography practitioners, by enhancing the research confidence of 'early stage' researchers (i.e. those with some exposure to research or experience as part of a project team and those with some research methods training but limited/no experience in grant application writing).

Parts of the day will focus on increasing the success of clinical based radiographers in gaining research award funds, with particular emphasis on the CoRIPS research award, and how to effectively present and disseminate research findings.
